

Ways to Pay the IRS

Direct debit from your bank account for free using the IRS's *Direct Pay*, found on their App (IRS2Go) or website (irs.gov/payments). To use this method, you need to pass an identity verification check. Sometimes you can't pass this and if you don't, try the next method.

If you want to pay with a credit card or you don't pass the IRS identity verification check, below is a list of third-party service providers who will accept your payment. You can call them or visit their websites directly (see below) or through the IRS App/website listed above. These companies charge fees: If you use a debit card, there's a flat fee (see column, *Convenience Fees-ATM/Debit-Card*). If you use a credit card, the fee is a percentage of your payment (see column, *Convenience Fees-Credit Card*).
